

Purim Fun at the Judaica Shop

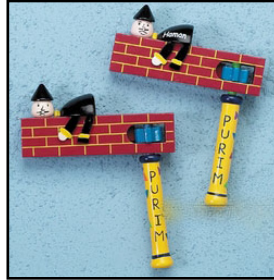

We have groggers to spin and noisemakers to drown out Haman's name, masks for your costume and baking accessories for your shalach manot or for baking Purim cookies for the family to enjoy. We hope you will stop in before Purim begins on Thursday evening, March 20.

Purim brings the added fun of not just be allowed, but being encouraged to make noise in synagogue! Our groggers make all different sounds that will increase the merriment. We have the Haman grogger that has

Haman clinging to the wall as you spin him around. At each turn, it makes all the loud noise needed to sound over Haman's name. Or try our inflatable grogger that squeaks when you squeeze the handle. At 15.5" when

inflated, it is sure to knock out Haman. Our sterling silver groggers, while functional, also make a beautiful gift.

If you can't decide on a costume, buy our pack of five masks: Esther, Vashti, Haman, Mordecai & King Achashverosh, each a comfortable and colorful layered foam mask.



We also have colorful plastic cookie cutters that are perfect for making Purim cookies or playing with clay. The set includes a cookie recipe and five brightly colored cookie cutters made especially for Purim: Grogger, mask, crown, megillah, and even a triangle for hamantaschen cookies. Put a smile on everyone's lips and not an inch on your hips when you wear this hamantasch pin. It is a delicious Purim shpiel (parody) that will never get stale and looks good enough to eat. The pin is designed by local polymer clay artist Deborah Lurie Edery and is handcrafted from Premo! polymer clay, tiny glass marbles and an embossing process to make sure that the "poppy seeds (mun)" filling remains fresh forever.



Lastly, come in and check out our selection of children's books about Purim, or make the Purim story come alive with these charming soft felt Purim characters: Haman, Mordecai, Vashti, Esther, and King Achashverosh finger puppets.
